## A Medium range weather forecast of IMD for next five days

Weather summary / Alert: Since dry weather condition is prevailed, irrigation of crops can be continued as per requirement. Below normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

## C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Ernakulum District (RRS Vyttila)

General Advisory: -Prophylactic measures can be taken to control crop pest & diseases. Proper mulching of crops can be followed to conserve soil moisture.

| Crop                                     | Pest/ Disease,<br>Crop Management | Agromet Advisory   |  |  |

| Paddy(Mundakan) Panicle initiation stage | Leaf folder                       | During cloudy weather condition, there is a chance of leaf folder attack in paddy. Trim the bunds and remove grassy weeds. Release of Trichogramma chilonis (5 cc / Ha) when moth activity is noticed. Set up light trap to monitor the moth population.   |  |  |
| Tree crops                               | Pink disease                      | the temperature increases, there is a chance of Pink disease in e crops. Drench and spray Hexaconazole 5EC 2ml per litre. Once rain subsides, cut the affected branches or swab 10% Bordeaux te or Copper oxy chloride (10g per litre).  |  |  |
| Cool season vegetables                   | Management                        | As the temperature increases, Necessary irrigation to be provided for cabbage and cauliflower till the formation of head / curd. Cover the curd with 3-4 surrounding leaves to prevent discoloration when the flower is half mature stage (blanching).   |  |  |
| Turmeric, cowpea, elephant foot yam      | Sclerotium rot                    | Store disease free planting materials for next crop. Before storing corms/rhizomes from diseased fields, treat them with 0.2% Mancozeb/Carbemndazim or <i>Trichoderma</i> (5 g per Kg seeds) dissolved in cow dung supernatant or 0.7% Nanma and dry in shade. Treat seeds with <i>Trichoderma</i> (5 g per Kg seeds) dissolved in cow dung supernatant before planting. |  |  |

Fish farming- Carp varieties like Catla, Rohu, Mrigal, Grass carp, Silver carp and Common carp and fishes like Varal, Kari, Pangasius and Tilapia can be suitable species for fresh water fish culture.
