Weather summary / Alert: As per the forecast of IMD, there is a chance of moderate rainfall in the district and heavy rainfall in isolated places. Above normal rainfall is expected in Kerala.

C. General and Agrometeorological Advisories for Thrissur District

Prophylactic measures to control crop pest & diseases can be taken to avoid their spread. Proper mulching can be followed to conserve soil moisture.

| Crop | Pest/ Disease | Crop/ Animal Advisory |

| Paddy (virippu season) Panicle stage | Rice bug | There is a chance of appearance of rice bug in paddy. To control, spray 2 ml malathion per one litre of water. Pesticides application should be done either before 9 am or after 3 pm. Otherwise, it will adversely affect the pollination. |
| Rice (Mundakan) transplanting | - | As a prophylactic measure, the root of seedlings can be soaked for 30 minutes in a solution of pseudomonas culture to control sheath blight, sheath rot, leaf spot disease etc. Before transplanting, spray 20 gram Pseudomonas in one litre of water. |
| Banana | - | Cut and remove the outer layer of the rhizome and sundry for 3 to 4 days after smearing it with slurry of cow dung and ash. |
| Ginger | Rhizome maggot | Apply neem cake in the basin of the crop. |
| Cucurbitaceous Vegetables | Downy mildew | There is a chance of downy mildew attack in cucurbitaceous vegetables. Spray 2.5gm Mancozeb per one litre of water under the leaves. |

Animal Husbandry: - Cattle feed should be stored on a wooden board or iron board. If moisture is in the cattle feed it may cause deadly fungal growth. Care should be taken to prevent rat breeding in the premises of cattle shed to prevent leptospirosis. (CAADECCS, KVASU, Mannuthy).
